

# God's Plan of Salvation

**God loves you and has a plan for your life!**

John 3:16 tells us:

*For this is the way God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.*

Jesus told us in John 10:10:

*I have come so that they may have life, and may have it abundantly.*

But **there's a problem**

Romans 3:23:

*For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*

Our **sin separates** us from God.

Romans 6:23:

*For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

**The great news** is that God made a way for us to be forgiven for our sins and have the gift of eternal life – through Jesus Christ, His Son!

I John 4:9:

*In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins.*

**Jesus died in our place** so we could have a relationship with God and be with Him forever.

Romans 5:8:

*But God demonstrates his own love for us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us*

**Jesus paid the price for our sin** by dying on the cross.  
But the story didn't end with His death.

**Jesus rose from death back to life and still lives!**

1 Corinthians 15:3-4

*For I passed on to you as of first importance what I also received—that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day according to the scriptures,*

**Jesus is the only way** we can be saved.

John 14:6

*Jesus replied, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life.  
No one comes to the Father except through me.*

Would you like to ask Jesus to forgive you and save you now?

**We cannot earn salvation** or do anything to deserve it.  
The Bible tells us that **salvation is a free gift** to us from God.

Ephesians 2:8-9

*For by grace you are saved through faith,  
and this is not from yourselves,  
it is the gift of God;  
it is not from works, so that no one can boast.*

All you have to do is recognize you are a sinner,  
confess that Jesus died for your sins, and ask His forgiveness.  
Then turn away from your sins—that's called **repentance**.

1 John 3:9-10

*No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God. 10 This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister.*

**Jesus Christ knows you, loves you and wants to have a relationship with you.**

If you would like to ask Jesus to forgive you, save you and live in your heart this is a prayer we hope you will **pray**:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness.  
I believe Jesus is Your Son, that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as my Lord, from this day forward. Please guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
